MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 7:03PM

ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Assistant Principal Zacharay Weagley talked about being new to the district and gave a little of his background information. He said this has been the best two weeks. He commented on how challenged the students have mentioned to him that they feel with an emphasis on education.

He discussed the Rebel Band Program that was started this year to recognize students for their positive efforts. She said we now have a second warmer that was donated from Longfellow Elementary School. She also mentioned that she wants to sell the pop that we have before placing another order.

Prom Fashion Show – Joyce Fiebig will have updates by the next meeting and intends to get started by December.

Spirit Wear – Jackie Messina reported some issues that resulted when non-members had gone into the supply closet without her knowledge. Also, she plans to sell only long-sleeve T-shirts or crew neck sweatshirts for the North v South Football spirit wear next year.

OLD BUSINESS: It was decided that the Spirit wear start up money would continue to be kept in the indoor concessions stand.

NEW BUSINESS: Lisa Stevens has notified the board members that she plans to tender her resignation as Rebel Families President. Lisa was not present at the meeting. Pattie Rinehart emailed her nomination of Julie Galicz as interim President.

Four students from Career Technical Education expressed gratitude for the Rebel Families donation that helped them attend the Skills USA National Leadership Conference.

Principal Ward said that this year's school opening has been one of the best he's seen in fifteen years. He reported that the Rebel Grow program is going well and that he was very excited by all the spirit exhibited during Spirit Week.
